⚠ Cautions

- The bracket should never remain connected to the power supply when not in use.
- It is imperative to turn off the power and disconnect the bracket after each usage.
- While this product is designed to be waterproof, it is not advisable to use it outdoors under conditions of extreme moisture or rain for extended durations.
- Adherence to the following steps is essential for proper use.
- ① Insert the "V-mount" battery, connect the power adapter, controller and light stand cables. Compatible battery voltage: 12-16.8V.
- (2) Initial reset: Simultaneously press and hold the up and down buttons for approximately 5 seconds to activate the stand reset. This only needs to be performed once during initial setup. After power cycling, the green indicator light confirms normal operation.
- 3 Dynamic demo: Simultaneously press and hold the stop and M1 buttons for approximately 5 seconds to activate the demonstration function.

- Memory height setting M1/M2: When reaching the desired height, press and hold the M1 button for approximately 5 seconds until thei ndicator light flashes to confirm the height setting. After height adjustment, press M1 once to return to the preset height.
- (5) After use: Remove the "V-mount" battery.

The battery may be depleted or have poor contact. Please check the battery level. If the battery is nearly drained, replace it with a fully charged one; if the contact is poor, clean the battery terminals to ensure proper connection.
