



Installation instructions


1. Connect the "6" shape connecting rod + caster column to complete parts A and B.




2. Use part C to join sections A and B together.



3. Connect the U-shaped connecting rod + short "6" shape connecting rod to complete part D.



4. Insert the D assembly into the turntable column.



5. Insert the acrylic board, then tighten all screws. Assembly complete. The shooting table can rotate up to 90°.
